Easter Celebration Preparation!





On Sunday morning, April 16, **Karen** will be leading both worship services sharing stories of her ministry in North Africa which is supported through the tithes and offerings of our congregation. Karen is the twin sister of Kimberly who is a member of our church. First Baptist serves as an Encourager Church for Karen as she ministers in North Africa.

On Wednesday evening, April 19, church members **Adam and Cori Willard** and their family will share updates about their ministry in Africa following our Wednesday night meal. Come hear the exciting things that God is doing through their ministry with African Inland Missions and through our church's financial and prayer support.

Finally, on Saturday, April 22 we will have a fantastic missions celebration with a Concert for the Children of Guatemala. On that evening our Baptist Men will be preparing a delicious meal for dinner, and Paul Saik will be providing a concert of Broadway and other contemporary music to help raise money for the Good Shepherd Ministry Orphanage which our church has supported for nearly 10 years now. The COVID epidemic placed many hardships on the orphanage in Guatemala from which they continue to recover. Baby formula had to be rationed. A moratorium on receiving new children had to be enacted. We as a church want to help the orphanage recover some of the \$150,000 of funding that they lost because of COVID. We hope that you will join us for this evening. And did I mention that Roger and Vicki Grossmann from Guatemala will be with us on April 22nd, as well. Tickets for this event will be \$20.00 and go on sale soon.

What an exciting month! Please join us and be a part of these many wonderful happenings.
