## **Orders Remained Unchanged**

Several years ago, I had the opportunity to tour Washington, D.C. with a group from First Baptist Church led by our own Howard Mathews. When you visit Washington, D.C., you encounter many monuments that remind you of our nation's heritage. There is no more powerful monument than the one located in northern Virginia at the Arlington National Cemetery. The vast sea of white crosses remind you of freedom's extravagant price tag. Every hour a dramatic event occurs in Arlington at the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** that amplifies the daunting task of our military. It also reminds us of the task of all those who have enlisted as a follower of Jesus Christ.

When the guardian of the sacred tomb has completed his duty and the transfer of the sentinel's responsibility occurs, a three-word exchange is made as the replacement soldier shoulders his responsibility. If you listen closely, you can hear the departing watchman say to his reliever during the changing of the guard, "Orders remain unchanged." For decades, that simple command has been exchanged twenty-four times each day at the top of the hour at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Christ, our Commander-in-Chief, speaks the same orders to our spirits: "My Beloved and faithful Child, your orders remain unchanged."

Jesus gave His followers a last command which should be our first priority. Jesus said, "Go and make disciples of all nations. Baptize them in the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Teach them all I have commanded you; and I will be with you to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20). These orders cannot be negated or re-negotiated. Jesus' orders remain unchanged. Are you in compliance or in disobedience? Are you sharing the love and light of Christ in such a magnetic way? Jesus calls us to attention. Our task is the most important on the planet: Share Jesus with everyone. Your orders remain unchanged!
